

## New 'Labour-Birth Mother' Encounter: Coming March 1st 2017

### What's changed?

- ✓ The 'Labour' and 'Birth Mother' encounters in the BIS will be merged into one 'Labour-Birth Mother' (LBM) encounter
- ✓ You must complete the new LBM encounter for **all women** regardless of type of labour or type of birth

### Why merge these encounters?

- ✓ The Labour and Birth encounters share numerous data elements and you've consistently told us that these elements belong together in one encounter
- ✓ Merging the encounters will make data entry easier and will improve data quality

### What hasn't changed?

- ✓ Data elements
- ✓ Process for data quality management (note: the data quality reports have very minor changes to the column titles)

#### Reminders:

The 'Labour Birth Mother' encounter captures the maternal experience up to the first hour post-birth.

**Save** – saves information in draft


**Proceed** - saves in draft and identifies missing information

**Submit** – submits completed encounters (all tabs); activates all validation rules and requires error correction before allowing successful submission




**What you need to know re: data entry**

1. For women having an **elective cesarean section**, enter 'no labour' in the TYPE OF LABOUR field

2. For women who are **admitted to your hospital and then transferred out prior to birth**, enter 'Transfer to other hospital' in the MATERNAL OUTCOME field on the Intrapartum tab; this will grey out the Birth and Outcome tabs (i.e. you don't have to enter information in these tabs).
