## When to complete the Antenatal General Encounter


### Antenatal General (AG) Encounter

- Complete the AG encounter to capture early pregnancy details **for women who are NOT in labour** (e.g. at the time of an ambulatory visit or when admitted to an antepartum unit).
- **Benefit:** When you submit the AG encounter (with no red flags) the information will pre-populate the *History* and *Pregnancy* tabs in the Labour/Birth Mother encounter. Saves time later!



### Labor/Birth Mother (LBM) Encounter

- **For women who are IN LABOR,** start with the LBM encounter; no need to complete the AG encounter.
- The LBM encounter has 6 tabs (including the same 2 tabs in the AG encounter).
- Always review/edit any pre-populated data elements.
