The 'What, Where and Why' of Key Indicator and Patient Experience Reports

'What, Where and Why'	Key Indicator (KI) Reports Maternal & Infant Summary	Infant & Maternal Patient Experience List
What is it?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A quick and user-friendly way to review frequencies/counts of various indicators • Modeled after the Niday KI Report 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A database download of record level labour, birth and postpartum data for a designated time period
Where do I find it?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click on Reporting • Go to the Clinical Reports Tab and then look under "Maternal Newborn Reports" 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click on Reporting • Go to the Clinical Reports Tab and then look under "Data Downloads Reports"
Why use these reports?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provides the frequency or counts of selected indicators to support program management activities • Useful for monitoring clinical practice and spotting flags that may need further investigation 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Allows organizations to undertake statistical analysis of record level data for their population • The csv formatted file can be imported into a Business intelligence tool, in-house database or report writing application • Excel compatible to manipulate and create pivot tables • Can be used with other reports to drill down to records of interest i.e., sort by data elements, identify records with missing data
