Changes to the Incomplete Infant Record, Incomplete NICU/SCN Records and Maternal-Infant Cross Encounter Discrepancy reports

“Not Created” and “Transfer Dates Don’t Match” have now been separated...

- Only “Not Created” records will appear in the Incomplete Infant Record & Incomplete NICU/SCN Records reports
- “Transfer Dates Don’t Match” records will now appear in a new tab in the Maternal-Infant Cross-Encounter Discrepancy Report named “BC, PPC – NICU Transfer Discrepancies” showing the Transfer Date/Time and the NICU/SCN Admit Date/Time

The NICU admission date/time must be within two hours of the Newborn Transferred To date and time on the Postpartum child encounter.
