### **BIS Users Able to Delete Post Partum Child (PPC) and NICU/SCN Encounters**

As of August 20, 2015 BIS users will be able to delete any **PPC** and **NICU/SCN** encounters inadvertently created!

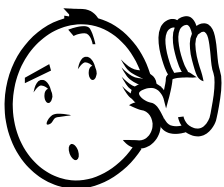
A 'Delete Encounter' button will appear at the bottom of the Encounter **on all tabs** (including the midwifery tab). When a user clicks this button for either the **Postpartum Child** or **NICU encounter**, a verification message will pop up.

For example, when deleting a Postpartum Child encounter:

**'All data entered in the Postpartum Child encounter will be lost. Are you sure you want to delete this entire Postpartum Child encounter?'**
