BORN Information BITS - NICU/SCN

This edition of the BITS focuses on helpful hints to improve the quality of the data for the NICU/SCN Encounter and Reporting.

NICU/SCN Encounter

All admissions to a NICU/SCN need to be entered in the BIS *regardless* of the length of stay and it is important that a new encounter is created for each readmission. **Rationale:** The data entered will help you understand neonatal care practices in order to identify data quality initiatives (e.g. strategies to decrease separating mothers and their babies). There is also a need to capture all NICU admissions in the province to monitor change.

Interventions

Enter the interventions for each NICU/SCN admission that take place in your unit! **<u>Do not</u>** enter interventions completed by the Transport Team, another NICU/SCN or from a previous admission/encounter to your NICU/SCN.

Highest Mode of Respiratory Support ... clarifying invasive and non-invasive ventilation

Invasive Ventilation	Non-Invasive Ventilation
Support <u>via</u> an endotracheal tube	Support <u>without</u> intubation
Invasive high frequency	CPAP
Intermittent positive pressure ventilation	Bi Pap
	NIPPV

How to Enter Non-Invasive and Invasive Ventilation Days?

When the infant receives full day(s) of ventilation support enter the whole number(s).




If ventilation support is less than 24 hours, the percentage of the day needs to be calculated by dividing the number of hours by 24. Eight hours = 8/24 = .33

Admission to NICU and Post Partum Child (PPC) Encounter

Infants who are admitted directly to and discharged from a NICU/SCN <u>do not</u> require a PPC encounter; all discharge and screening information is captured in the NICU/SCN encounter.



NICU/SCN Profile on Discharge Report



Provides an infant and maternal discharge summary that can be printed and given to parents to share with their baby's health care provider (HCP) at the first follow up visit.

If additional information, not captured in the BIS, is needed it may be added manually or electronically onto the form.

Field Level Help

"?" will appear when scrolling over any data element. Clicking on any data element will provide a definition for that data element (always in constant development).




Data Dictionary

Data Quality and Clinical Reports


The data entered is available via the reporting portal. Take advantage of the ready-made opportunities for monitoring quality and benchmarking with comparator groups.



Incomplete NICU/SCN Records – Provides direction to create and submit encounters that may be missed and to correct discrepancies.

Missing Data Elements – NICU/SCN – Provides opportunity to identify where data elements are missing or coded as unknown are: >30%, 10-30% or 5-10%. Note: missing/unknown data to be < than 5% to increase confidence in analysis.

Reconciliation – NICU/SCN – Provides listing of all NICU/SCN records for comparison against other hospital data sources to ensure **100% capture of all admissions.**



NICU/SCN Profile -- Provides the rate of NICU/SCN admissions by gestational age, birth weight, and acuity, as well as NICU/SCN outcomes and the distribution of infant length of stay; includes hospital data and *comparator data* from similar level of care hospitals and birth volume hospitals.

Encounter List NICU -- Spreadsheet view of all the infant records for the NICU/SCN encounter (e.g. Apgar scores, arterial cord blood results). Exporting to excel allows filtering data elements for analysis.
