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# BORN *Information* BITS

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## MIDWIFERY SERIES – ACTIVE PRACTICE REPORTS

The BORN Information System (BIS) has incorporated two Active Practice Reports to support midwifery users in meeting their College of Midwives of Ontario reporting.

1. **Active Practice Report** - Courses of Care (CoC) entered into BIS (current system).
2. **Active Practice Report (Legacy)** – Courses of Care entered into OMP Maternal Newborn Reporting System (the previous system which includes Courses of Care billed through March 2012)

The reports are generated to list all Courses of Care, by place of birth, where the midwife was the primary or secondary midwife.

### Who can generate this report?

Any Midwife with data entry permissions can run this data for his/her own courses of care. These reports are not available at the practice group level. The midwife user must have access to data entry in the BIS in order to generate the report. BIS Local Administrators can enable access to data entry. Midwife users can confirm access to the report by checking under Reporting : Administrative Reports: Midwives Active Practice.

### What information is provided in the Active Practice Reports?

The information contained in these reports includes Client Code (CC) and midwifery practice group (MPG) number where the midwife is the primary or secondary attending midwife, by actual place of birth. Where the midwife was the primary attending midwife, the client's planned place of birth (at the beginning of intrapartum period) is also listed.

In the example report below, for CC 1235, the user should follow across the columns. The midwife pulling the report was the primary attending midwife at this birth.

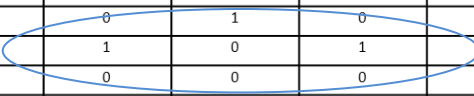
Because this midwife was primary, both the planned and actual Place of Birth (POB) is displayed. This Client planned a hospital birth and actually gave birth at the hospital.

Where the midwife pulling the report was the second attending midwife, the planned Place of Birth is not displayed. **Both planned and actual Places of Birth are listed for the primary midwife ONLY.**

**Note : These reports support the College reporting requirements. The reports do not remove Transfers of Care. They provide a list of all the Courses of Care where midwives have been listed as the primary or secondary midwife from April 2006 by place of birth.**

**What parameters are used in the Reports?**

Both Active Practice Reports are queried using newborn date of birth. These reports are queried by midwife name and will include affiliations at more than one practice group.

### How do we generate the Active Practice Reports?

Midwife users with access to data entry can run the Active Practice Reports. Practice Administrators with access to practice level reports will NOT be able to run these Active Practice Reports.



The current system report is named Midwives Active Practice.


The previous system report is called Midwives Active Practice Legacy.

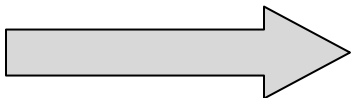
